Independent Foundation

CCFSD is an autonomous pious Foundation formed under canon law and is a tax-exempt nonprofit under civil law. The foundation is independent from the Diocese of San Diego and has its own board of trustees.

Donor-centricity is a core principle of the Foundation. All fund distributions from our donors are fulfilled in a manner that respects and honors each donor's fund intentions. The Foundation encourages purposeful giving to those Catholic and other charitable organizations that are personal and spiritually meaningful to each donor; thereby proclaiming their Catholic identity and leaving a legacy to those organizations which are near and dear to their hearts.

Vocations


